#### From the FAUC Chair

Is there a difference between 12<sup>th</sup> Step Work and Service Work?

Let's look at a Soup Kitchen for a practical example. Donations to the kitchen are from one to the needful with no involvement of the work being done. This in no way diminishes the importance of the donation. One who works in the kitchen, in what ever way, is involved, and working with others to serve the needful. These are the two types of help to the needful.

Service (the worker) is an extension of the 12<sup>th</sup> Step (the donator). A.A. suggests that "the 12<sup>th</sup> Step Call of visiting an alcoholic may be the beginning of a sponsorship, but by itself is not necessarily the needed sponsorship." (P-15, Questions and Answers on Sponsorship, page 8, reprinted with permission of A.A.W.S.).

So let's be mindful to reach out and work with others who work with others in our recovery to fulfill our own Service Work needs.

Working at a Treatment Center, a Jail, or being on a District Committee fulfills this. By Doug G.

#### FLINT AREA UNITY COUNCIL AIMS AND PURPOSES

- To promote Unity among Flint Area A.A., and harmony with Al-Anon and Ala-teen groups
- To exchange group ideas.
- 3. The G.S.R.'s and Alternates shall act as trusted servants of their groups.
- 4. Each group shall be represented by a G.S.R. or Alternate. One vote per group shall be allowed in the determining matters of policy and action affecting the groups. (Committee persons are allowed one vote.)
- 5. To continue advancement of Twelve Step work and sponsorship.
- 6. To help financially any member group of this Council who needs help. A two-thirds majority vote will pass on any such loans which shall not be in excess of sixty days.
- 7. The Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts of A.A. shall prevail at all times.
- 8. No monies will be spent or sent out of the Council area without a two-thirds majority vote of the groups that have paid into the council in the last three months. If they are not present they will be contacted for a vote on the issue within one week.
- 9. The Council will create service committees and be financially responsible for them.

The FAUC A.A. Answering Service has served the Community in and around Flint for many, many years. It is my pleasure to be your current Chair of this much needed service to the still suffering alcoholic.

The G.S.O. guidelines for this committee answers the question "WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ANSWERING SERVICE? ...the answering service may be the responsibility of the district or area general service committee." "WHO ANSWERS THE PHONES — A.A. MEMBERS OR COMMERCIAL ANSWERING SERVICE PERSONNEL? Some answering services rely on A.A. members exclusively. Many answering services hire a commercial service which answers the phone and connects callers to an A.A. group or A.A. contact."

The FAUC is the District 12 Unity Council and uses a commercial answering service to relay calls via computer switchboard to an A.A. member. No person talks to the caller until they are connected to A.A. "The importance of keeping the list of volunteer Twelfth-Step workers up to date and on a rotating basis cannot be over-emphasized." (MG-12; A.A. Guidelines, reprinted with permission of A.A.W.S.)

There are currently 21 volunteers on the "Helpline" who are rotated monthly.
